

PATRON SAINT REPORT AND POSTER GUIDELINES

This rubric is to be used as a guide while researching your patron saint for Confirmation. You are required to write a report *in your own words* and create a poster to honor your patron saint as a part of your Confirmation preparation at St. Bernard. Reports and posters that are incomplete or plagiarized (remember the words: 'Thou shall not steal') will not be accepted and will be returned until deemed authentic. **Don't procrastinate.** This project will be much more meaningful if you take your time and do your research. Choose a saint that is truly special to you. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you!

The Report...

Report is to be:

- no more than two pages in length, typed
 - single-spaced
 - size 12 point font 1" margins or .5" margins
 - Attach your report to the front of your poster with staples or glue
 - Use at least two sources and cite them
 - You will present your poster and a shortened version of your report to class on the due date.
- create note cards and practice what you want to say.

Be sure the following details are included in your report:

- Title with saint's name
- When he/she lived
- Where he/she lived
- Important facts about the saint's life such as their feast day, their special devotions and symbols for which they are known
- Why you chose this particular person
- What you admire about him/her
- How was this person like Jesus Christ
- How do you plan to follow him/her as a role model
